MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

Sets up and/or operates conventional, computer numerical control machines and machining centers to machine metallic and nonmetallic parts to established specifications. May be required to run all types of grinders, lathes, jig bores, jig grinders, vertical and horizontal machining centers.

PRINCIPAL ACCOUNTABILITIES

1. Uses blueprints, sketches, drawings, manuals or other specifications to determine dimensions and tolerances of work pieces, setup requirements and sequence of operations. Must be proficient with Geometric Dimensioning and Tolerancing.
2. Applies knowledge of machining theory and procedures to the operation of various types of equipment and processes.
3. Sets up and operates machines on trial runs to verify accuracy of machine settings or programmed control data. May edit, prove out and verify accuracy of CNC machines.
4. Uses specifications, dimensions and tolerances to machine parts as well as verifying conformance of parts. Must be able to work with tolerances within one ten-thousands of an inch.
5. Monitors processes to detect malfunctions or out-of-tolerance machining, and adjusts machine controls as required. May be required to problem solve for CNC machines.
6. Monitors processes to detect malfunctions or out-of-tolerance machining, and adjusts machine controls as required.
7. Initiates improvements to processes, parts, tooling, and equipment. Will be required to work in a team environment to ensure continuous process and quality improvement.
8. Conducts preventive and corrective actions to assure continuous process and quality improvement.
